

2007 Experimental Program to Stimulate Competitive Research (EPSCoR); Building EPSCoR-State/National Laboratory Partnerships

The US Department of Energy has released the “Building EPSCoR-State/National Laboratory Partnerships, #07-15” call for proposals. These funds are limited to Idaho researchers who do not currently have DOE EPSCoR or DOE funds. Researchers may submit only one pre-application, which means they may not serve as PI on one project and co-PI on another.

Following are instructions for the submission of the DOE Lab Partnership pre-proposals from Idaho.

These are instructions for actually submitting the pre-proposals. Faculty must also follow any additional institutional procedures for submitting pre-proposals for external support.

To apply, there is a pre-application process that must be followed. These can be found through Grants.gov at:

IN ADDITION to the guidelines in the call for proposals, each applicant must do the following:

By April 15, 2007 submit a PDF file to office_of_research@isu.edu consisting of a coversheet with the information described in the call, the three to five page pre-application described in the call, and the letter of collaboration from a DOE National Lab researcher, also described in the call. A letter of endorsement from the ID DOE EPSCoR coordinator will be added to the PDF file and sent, via email, to Dr. Kristin Bennett at DOE, by the April 30, 2007 deadline.

It is important that they secure the call for proposals and other pre-application instructions. The pre-application must address all items in the call. Note that the call for proposals directs proposal writers to a website at DOE giving additional instructions for the pre-application.
